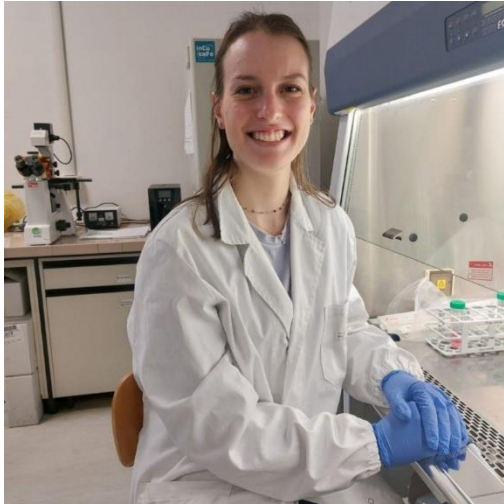


Presentation of Chiara Botrini, a PhD student from University of Pisa



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Brief presentation:

Chiara Botrini is a first-year PhD student in Clinical Physiopathology at the University of Pisa. Her research focuses on anaplastic thyroid cancer, the most aggressive and lethal form of thyroid malignancy, with the aim of identifying new potential therapeutic strategies. She is currently investigating the efficacy of a combination of specific inhibitors targeting the altered signaling pathways characteristic of this cancer. Using human primary cell cultures derived from patients with anaplastic thyroid cancer, her work seeks to contribute to the development of more effective and personalized treatment options. In addition to her research on anaplastic thyroid cancer, she has a strong interest in thyroid eye disease and is actively involved in clinical trials dedicated to this pathology.

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
